Today I was reviewing the Amended Ordinance 2016-06-12 that was posted on the gird on June 28th and read paragraph 1.8. I had not previously seen it. So I am now aware that the Councilors "considered" the DOC comments. The remaining parts of my letter remain the same as we are surprised that Councilors could reject the DOC's strongly worded comments without public comment. FOCC still strongly urges reconsideration of the decision made in Amended Ordinance 2016-06-12 given the likely adverse ramifications of the land divisions versus the lack of prejudice that would be caused by any delay in the implementation of the effective date for those land divisions.
