Once again, Clark County citizens made history. This time, the Referendum Petition is to suspend the ordinance passed by Marc Boldt, Julie Olson, and Jeanne Stewart that stripped rural citizens of their private property rights.

The Referendum Petition was turned in last Friday. This week will reveal whether the same county council majority will respect the rural citizens' Referendum Petition and act to address their concerns.

We, the citizens of Clark County by signing this Referendum Petition, notify the Clark County Auditor that Ordinance# 2016-06-12, "An ordinance relating to land use; adopting an updated Growth Management Comprehensive Land Use Plan, zoning maps and zoning ordinances; providing for severability; providing an effective date; and requiring notice" passed by the Clark County Council on June 28, 2016, is to be suspended until the provisions of Charter Section 7.4.8 are fulfilled.
