Christian Berrigan filed a referendum petition and more than 100 signatures were verified. Once verification took place the Ordinance in question, 2016-06-12 was suspended pending for 120 days or possibly longer if enough signatures were obtained to put the referendum on the ballot Once suspended Clark County lacked authority to receive development applications Clark County challenged the referendum in Superior court based on cases that concluded that GMA ordinances such 2016-06-12 were required by state law and not subject to referendum

On Friday Aug. 5th, the court ruled that Ordinance 2016-06-12 was required by state law. Given the ruling of the court and the language of the County Charter, the petition filed by Christian Berrigan was declared invalid. Therefore, the suspension of applications based on the new comprehensive plan is rescinded and Clark County is able to accept applications for development in areas modified by Ord. 2016-06-12
