Clark County revised its Comprehensive Growth Management Plan in 2016 as required by the Growth Management Act (GMA), RCW 36.70A. The County prepared a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) as part of the update process and adopted the 2007 Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) as well. The county's 2016 Comprehensive Plan was appealed to the Growth Management Hearings Board, and the Hearings Board has issued its final decision and order (FDO). The county is in the process of taking steps to comply with a number of issues in the FDO.

This notice announces the County's intent to adopt the 2007 Comprehensive Plan update EIS and the 2016 SEIS pursuant to WAC 197-11-600, in response to the appeal of the 2016 comprehensive plan.
