A. 2016 Comprehensive Growth Management Plan Update Remand:

Clark County completed the update of its comprehensive plan to meet the Growth Management Act (GMA) deadline of June 30, 2016. The plan was appealed to the Growth Management Hearings Board (GMHB) and a hearing on the issues was held February 8, 2017. The GMHB ruled on March 23, 2017 that certain portions of the 2016 plan update had not complied with certain requirements of GMA. The Board will consider recommendations by the Planning Commission on the following proposals as responses to the GMHB rulling: Changes to the comprehensive plan map.

1. Changing the zoning of AG-10 and FR-20 parcels back to AG-20 and FR-40, respectively, as they were before the update;

2. Changing certain R-10 parcels back to R-20, as they were before the update;

3. Amending the map to provide for three different Rural designations, as there were before the update:

4. Removing 17 parcels from the Battle Ground urban growth area, as it was before

8. INTERIM ORDINANCE ON LAND DIVISIONS ON RURAL AND RESOURCE LANDS
The Board of County Councilors adopted Ordinance 2017-04-14 on April 25, 2017 which put a moratorium on the filling, or receipt by County staff, of development applications, including pre-applications, for land divisions pursuant to CCC 40,210,010 and Chapter 40,540 CCC or zone changes pursuant to CCC 40,560,020, in the AG-10, FR-20, R-5, R-10, and R-20 zones. By state law (RCW 35,63,200), a public hearing on an interim ordinance has to be held within 60 days on the proposed moratorium or interim zoning control. The Board will consider at a public hearing what to do about the ordinance.
